Sealed bids will be received at the office of Williams Blackstock Architects, 2204 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South Suite 200 Birmingham, AL 35233, until 2:00 p.m., CT, Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021, for an Addition to the Mt Laurel Branch of North Shelby Library located at 111 Olmsted Street, Birmingham, AL, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the Main Conference Room, of North Shelby Library.

A walkthrough of the existing library and site will be held at 2:00 p.m., Thursday May 6<sup>th</sup>, located at 111 Olmsted Street, Birmingham, AL 35242. Interested parties are recommended to also review bid documents for a concurrent project “NORTH SHELBY LIBRARY – INTERIOR RENOVATION” for potential of being contracted to perform both projects.

Certified checks or bid bonds payable to “North Shelby Library” in an amount not less than five (5) per cent of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than \$10,000.00 per project, must accompany the bidder's proposal. Completed Disclosure Statements are preferred to accompany the proposal. Performance and Payment bonds will be required at the signing of the contract.

All bidders bidding in amounts exceeding \$50,000.00 must be licensed under the provisions of Title 34, Chapter 8, Code of Alabama, 1975.
